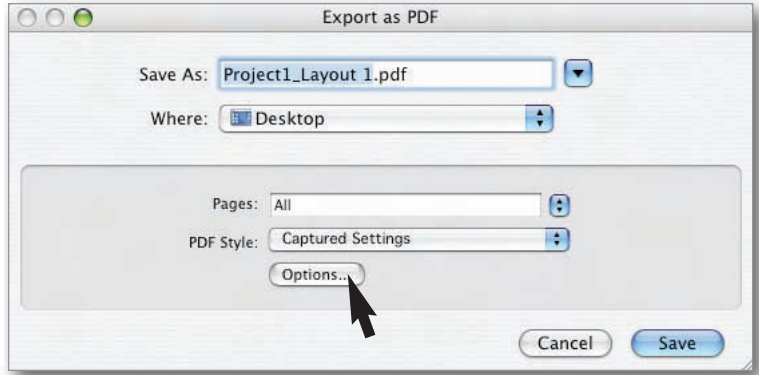
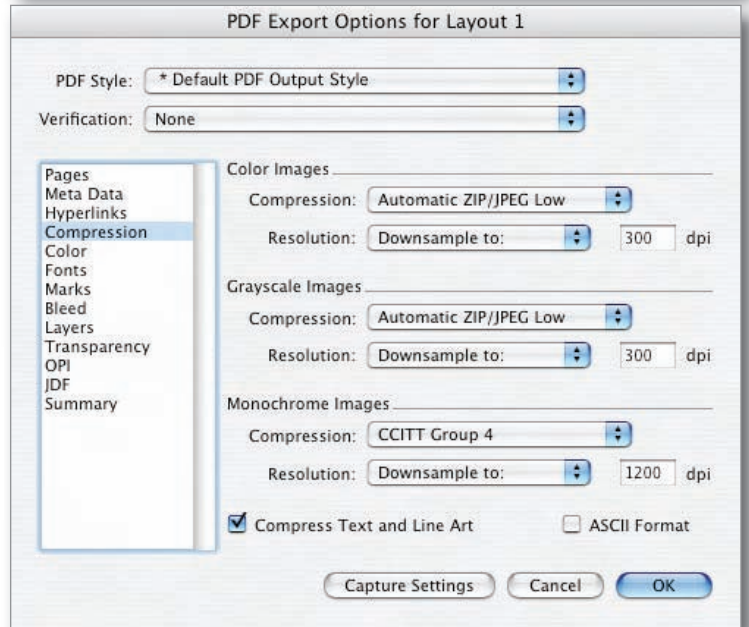
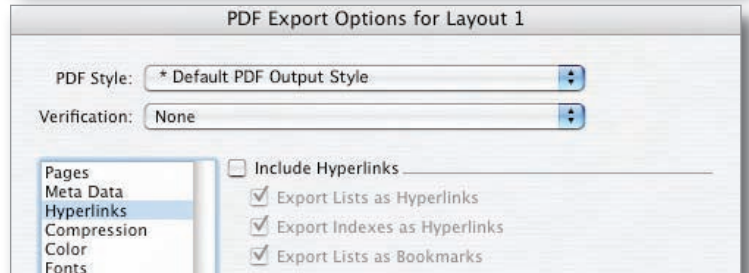
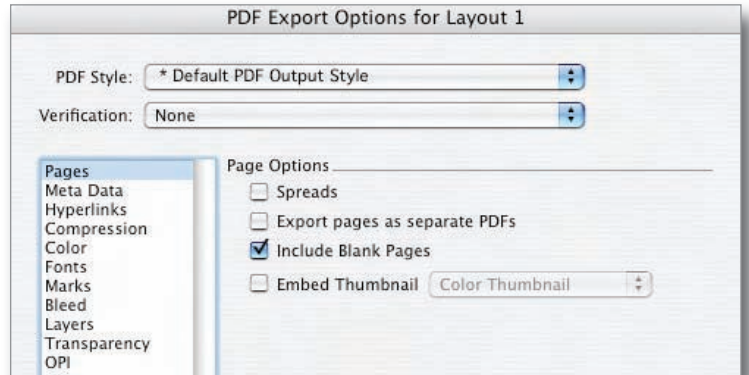


To create a PDF using the export option: Choose File - Export - Layout as PDF. A dialog box will appear. Enter a file name, choose where to save the PDF, and specify the pages to export. If you've already created a PDF Style, then select it and click Save. If not, then click on Options...



The PDF Export Options will appear. Change the settings to match those shown below.

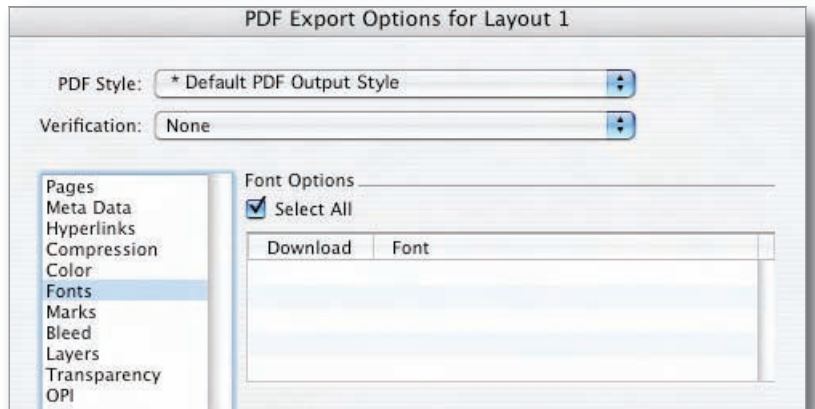
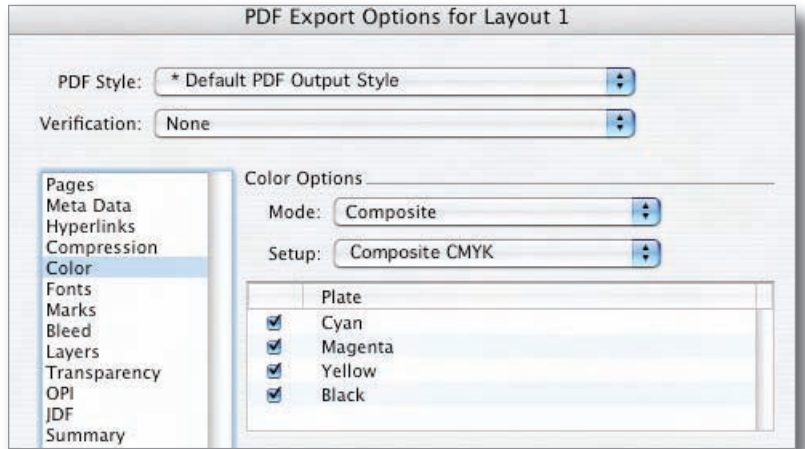
Quark 7 has the ability to create single page PDF's for all of the pages at once. To do this, check the "Export pages as separate PDFs" box.



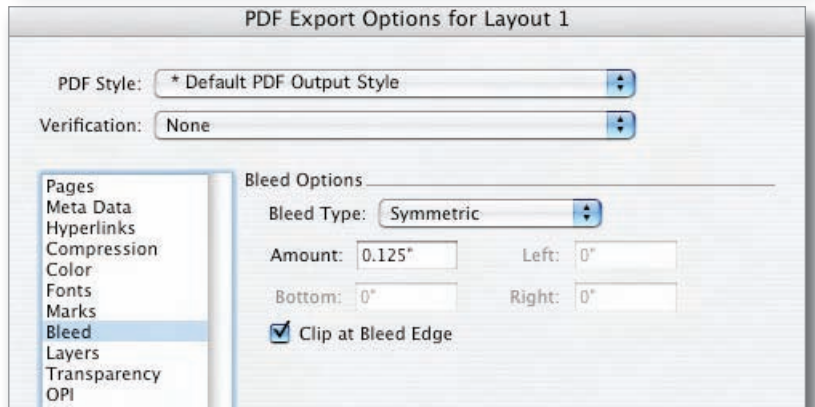
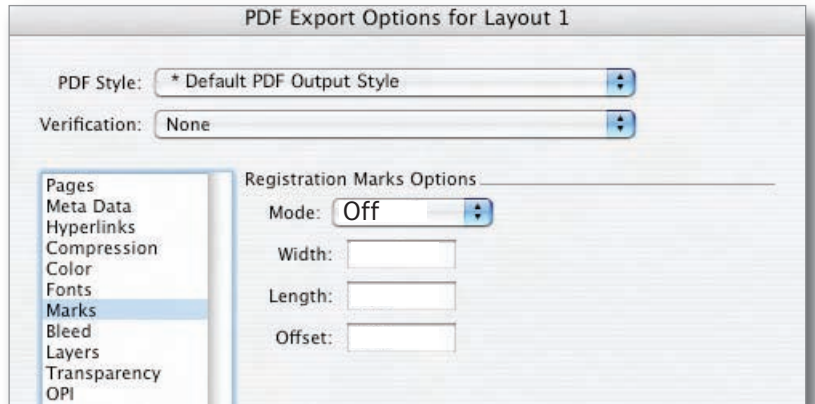
Compression should be set to low. (Low compression means maximum quality)

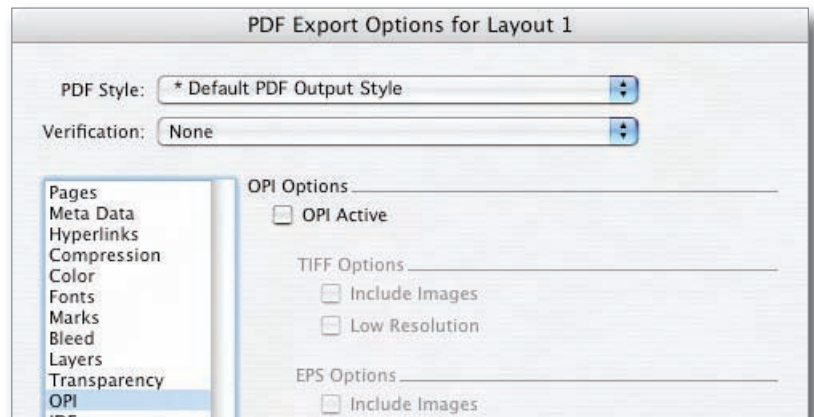
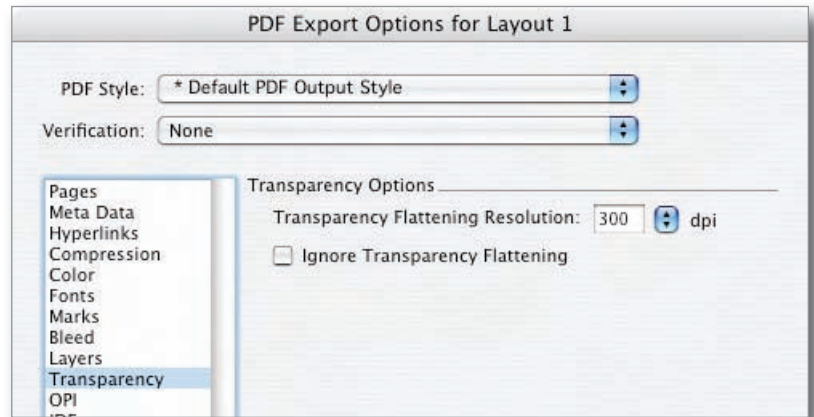
If you need to include a spot color, change the setup to CMYK plus Spot. Otherwise Composite CMYK should be used.



Page size should match the trim size of the project.

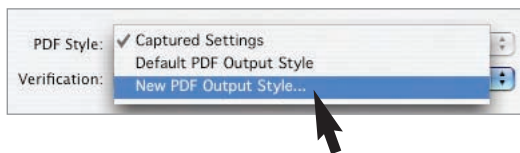

OPI should not be active.

Now click the PDF Style drop down menu and choose New PDF Output Style... (as shown below)



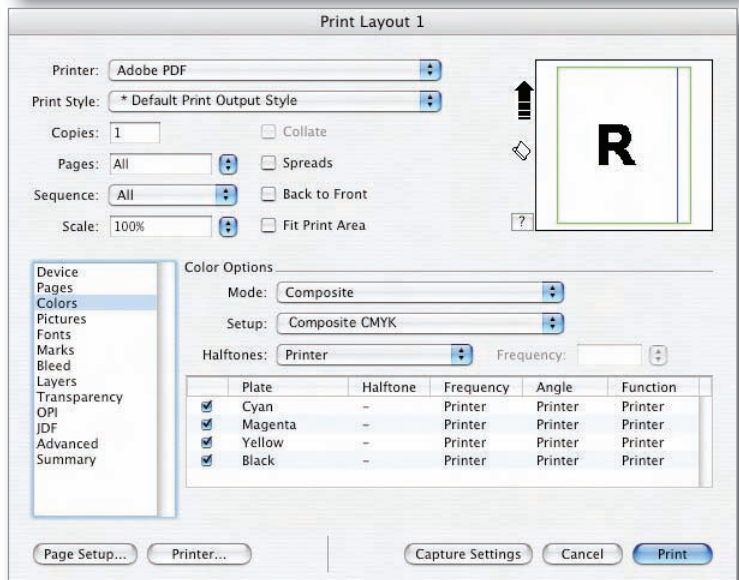
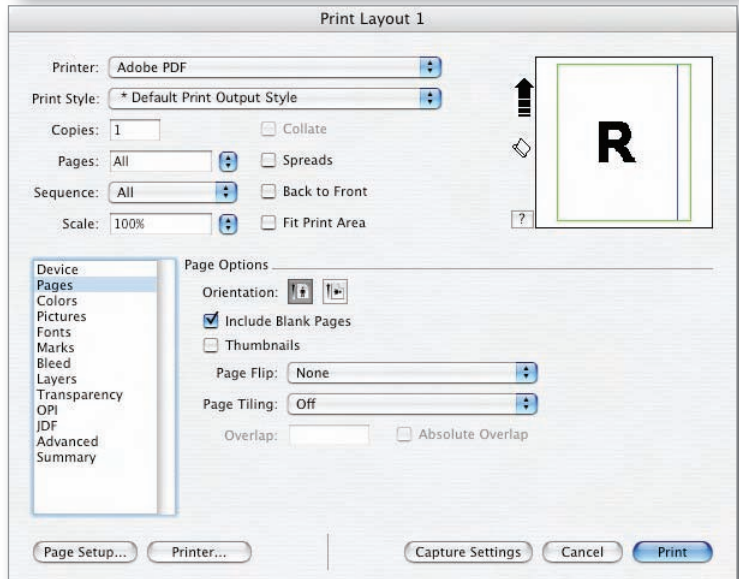
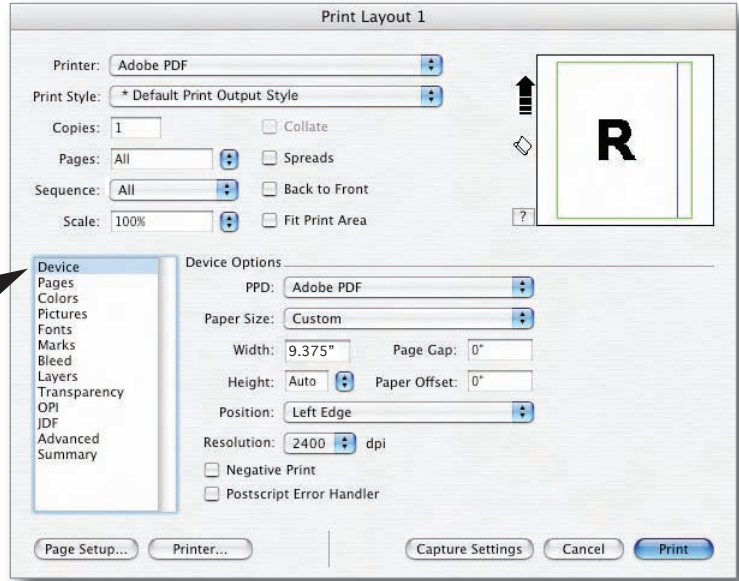
Name the PDF Style and then click done. Select the new PDF Style and click on Save in the Export as PDF window. Next time you export a PDF, you can simply select the PDF Style because all of the options have been saved.

PRI recommends creating PDFs from Quark 7 in one of two ways. Exporting a PDF as shown on the previous pages is one way, and printing a postscript to distill into a PDF is the second. If you wish to create PDFs using the second method, proceed on to the next page.

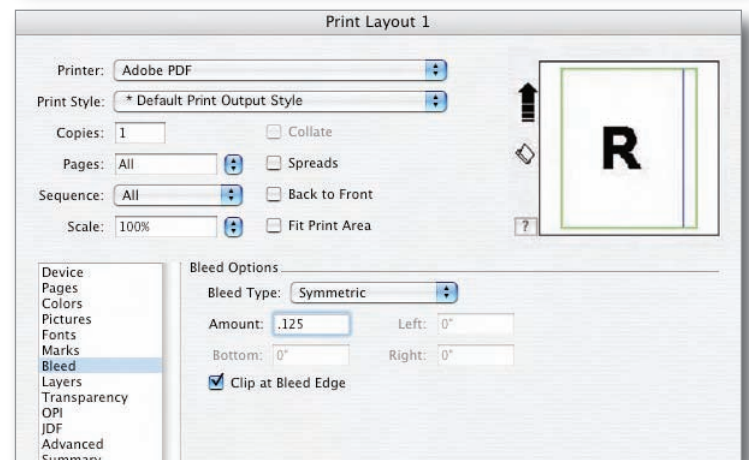
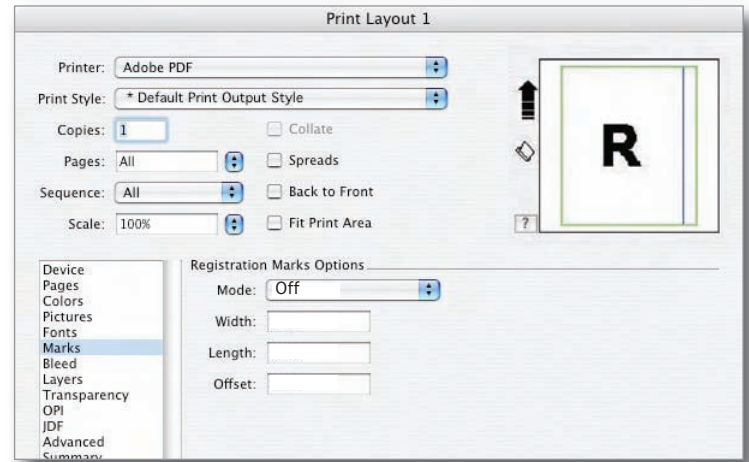
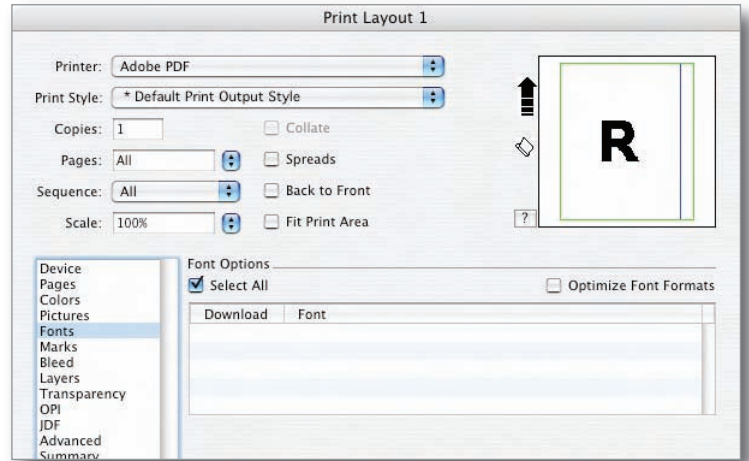
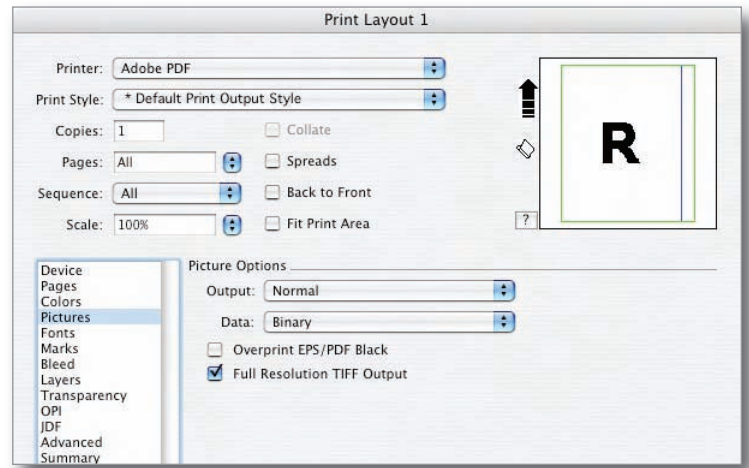
Use these settings to make a postscript file from Quark. You will then run that postscript through Acrobat Distiller to make a PDF.

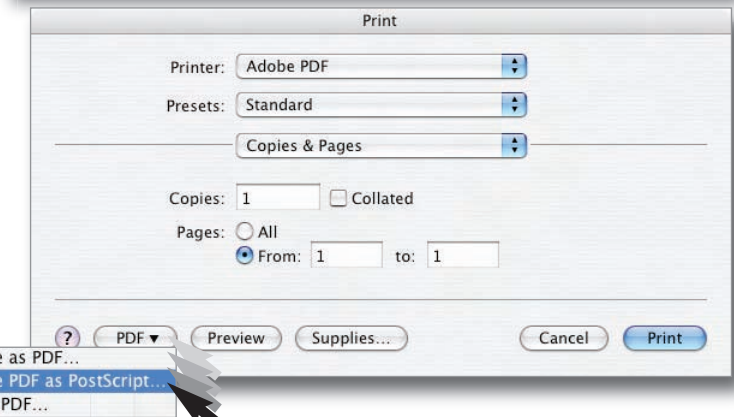
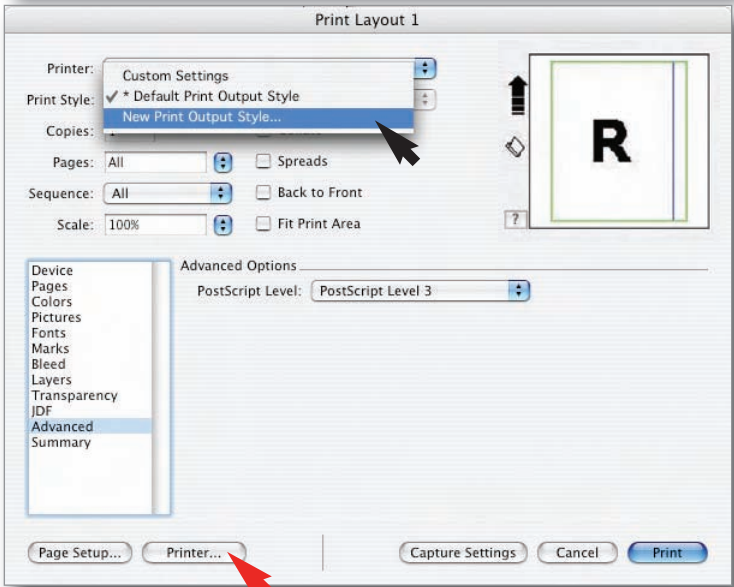
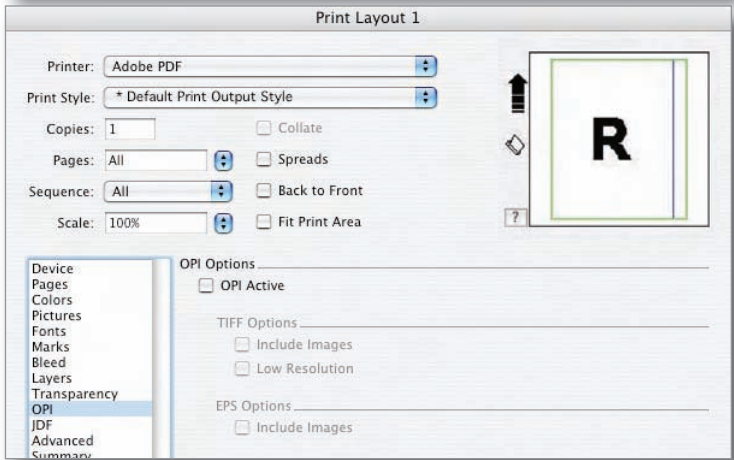
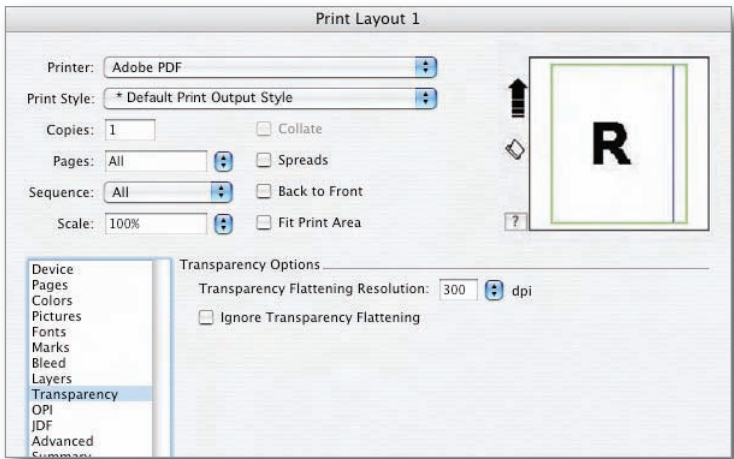
Beginning with the Device options, make your settings match these screen captures.

Set the Width to trim size of your project.



If running a spot color, change the Setup to CMYK plus Spot. Otherwise, Composite CMYK should be used.





OPI should not be active.

Once all of the options are set, select New Print Output Style under the Print Style drop down menu.

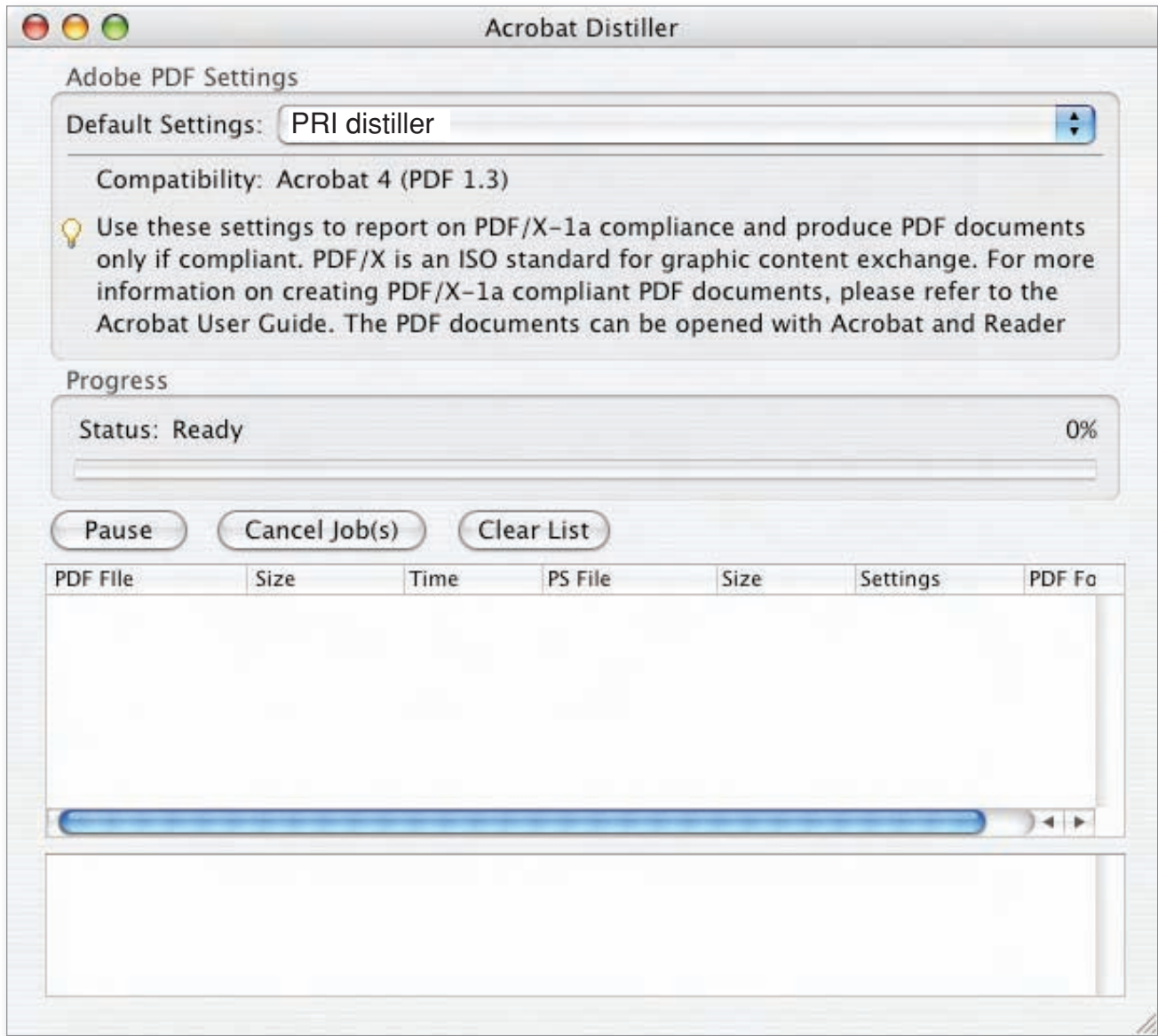
Name the Print Style. All the settings have now been saved for future use.

Click on Printer. (Not Print)

Choose Adobe PDF for the Printer, and then click on the PDF drop down menu at the bottom left. Select Save PDF as PostScript...

Name the file, and choose where to put it. Click Save. Click Print.

Now that you've got a ppostscript, it needs to be run through Distiller to make a PDF.' You can get the PRI Default Settings file from www.performanceracing.com/magazine



If you have Acrobat Professional, you have the ability to set up watched folders in Acrobat Distiller. To set up a watched folder, use the short cut "command-F" (control-F on a PC). Click "Add" and choose the folder where you placed your postscripts. Distiller will automatically create "In" and "Out" folders. Move your postscript files to the "In" folder and Distiller will automatically create PDF files in the out folder.
