

PRI SHOW EXHIBITOR CODE OF CONDUCT

The PRI Show is committed to providing a professional, safe, and welcoming environment for exhibitors, attendees, contractors, vendors, staff, and guests. Exhibitors are expected to conduct themselves in a manner that reflects positively on their company, the racing industry, and the PRI community.

By participating in the PRI Show, exhibitors agree to adhere to the following standards of conduct:

Professionalism and Respect

Exhibitors, their employees, representatives, contractors, and guests shall conduct themselves in a courteous, respectful, and professional manner at all times while participating in the PRI Show, including during move-in, show days, special events, and move-out.

APPROPRIATE BEHAVIOR

Exhibitors are expected to:

- Treat all exhibitors, attendees, service providers, facility personnel, and PRI staff with dignity, courtesy, and respect.
- Maintain a professional atmosphere within and around their exhibit space.
- Communicate concerns, disagreements, or operational issues in a constructive and respectful manner.
- Comply with all applicable show rules, venue policies, and safety regulations.

PROHIBITED CONDUCT

The following behaviors are not acceptable and may result in corrective action, including removal from the event without refund:

- Harassment, intimidation, discrimination, or bullying of any kind.
- Use of abusive, threatening, obscene, or offensive language.
- Aggressive, disruptive, or disorderly behavior.
- Physical altercations or threatening gestures.
- Conduct that interferes with another exhibitor's ability to conduct business or negatively impacts the experience of attendees.
- Damage to exhibit spaces, facility property, or another party's property.
- Failure to comply with reasonable requests from PRI staff, venue personnel, or official service contractors.

COMPLIANCE AND ENFORCEMENT

PRI reserves the right to determine what constitutes unacceptable behavior and to take appropriate action to maintain a professional environment. Actions may include verbal warnings, removal of individuals from the exhibit hall or event functions, closure of an exhibit, loss of exhibiting privileges, or denial of participation in future PRI events.
